I. Complete Atonement

- a. The cause of our completeness in Christ
- b. The work of Christ in our completeness
 - i. Complete blotting out all sin!

Problems with neglecting confession:

- Unconfessed sin causes a rift between God and sinner
- Unconfessed sin hardens our hearts
- Unconfessed sin causes the sinner to forget their sin

Blessings with confession:

- A tender conscience
